November 15th is the Liturgy Ministers Meeting. Changes in the liturgy will be presented. All facets of all ministries will be covered.

The weekend of November 22, 23, (The Feast of Christ the King), the blessing of ministers and the commissioning of the new eucharistic ministers will take place at all masses.

Thanksgiving, November 27, 10 a.m. Mass, is the celebration of the anniversary of the dedication of the Cathedral. The bishop will be the celebrant. There will be a historical reading. The collection will be for the poor. There is a large article in this week's Inland Register concerning this event.

November 29-30 is the first Sunday of Advent. The blessing of the Advent wreath will occur only at the 5 p.m. Mass. All other Masses the candles will be lighted with a reading.

On December 7, at the 11 a.m. Mass, The Rite of Acceptance will occur. There was some discussion whether to include the congregation at that point in the rite or wait for the Rite of Welcome. It was decided that it was more appropriate at the Rite of Welcome.

The Feast of the Immaculate Conception is Monday, December 8. Masses at 6:30 a.m., noon and 7 p.m. After the 7 p.m. Mass, the University High School Choir will be performing.

December 12, is The Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. There will be a "traditional ritual Mass" at St. Joseph's at 7 p.m. At 7:30 p.m. at the Cathedral, the Cathedral Choir will be performing at concert.

December 19, a prayer service for Posada will occur. This is part of the devotional history of the church.

#### CHRISTMAS MASS SCHEDULE:

Christmas Eve: Masses at 4 p.m., 7 p.m. and midnight.

Christmas Day: Masses at 6:30 a.m. and 10 a.m.

In an effort to get more people to Midnight Mass it was decided that we will publicize it in the newspapers and on radio. We will also mention it from the pulpit.

Next meeting of the Liturgy Committee is schedule for December 11 at 3 p.m.
